

Handle the N2-Levelsensor with extreme care!

- **Remove the N2-levelsensor carefully from the cardboard box.**
- **Try to hold the sensor in an upright position when carrying it around.**
- **Bend the hinge only when necessary**
- **Do not apply force to the tubes of the N2-levelsensor**
- **The hinge is bendable just in one direction. Bending it in the wrong direction destroys the hinge.**
- **Introduce the sensor carefully in the nitrogen turret. If it hits any resistance do not apply force but rather try a different turret.**
